# BEAR LAKE TOWNSHIP Ordinance No. 9-05 of 2005

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BEAR LAKE TOWNSHIP LAKE ACCESS ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF ORVS ON ROAD ENDINGS AND PUBLIC ACCESS SITES

THE TOWNSHIP OF BEAR LAKE ORDAINS:

### Section 1. Amendment of Section 3.

Section 3 of the Bear Lake Township Lake Access Ordinance is hereby amended to add the following definitions in their appropriate alphabetical locations:

- (i-1) "Operate" means to ride in or on, and be in actual physical control of the operation of an ORV.
- (i-2) "ORV" means a motor driven off-road recreation vehicle capable of cross-country travel without benefit of a road or trail, on or immediately over land, snow, ice, marsh, swampland, or other natural terrain. ORV includes, but is not limited to, a multitrack or multiwheel drive vehicle, an ATV, a motorcycle or related 2-wheeled, 3-wheeled, or 4-wheeled vehicle, an amphibious machine, a ground effect air cushion vehicle, or other means of transportation deriving motive power from a source other than muscle or wind. ORV does not include a registered snowmobile, a farm vehicle being used for farming, a vehicle used for military, fire, emergency, or law enforcement purposes, a vehicle owned and operated by a utility company or an oil or gas company when performing maintenance on its facilities or on property where it has an easement, a construction or logging vehicle used in performance of its common function, or a registered aircraft.

### Section 2. Amendment of Section 4.

Section 4 of the Bear Lake Township Lake Access Ordinance is hereby amended to add a new subsection (i) which shall read in its entirety as follows:

(i) Operate an ORV on a road ending or public access site.

#### Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective the day after being published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township.
