ORDINANCE 08-01 OF 2008

An ordinance to provide financial reimbursement to the Bear Lake Township Fire Department under certain circumstances.

TOWNSHIP FIRE AND RESCUE REIMBURSEMENT ORDINANCE

THE TOWNSHIP OF BEAR LAKE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Purpose

This ordinance is adopted for the purpose of providing financial reimbursement to the Bear Lake Township Fire Department (hereafter referred to as BLTFD), a service operated by Bear Lake Township, for fire response and/or rescue services performed throughout the BLTFD area of operation.

Section 2: Charges

The following charges shall be billed to any recipient of services provided by BLTFD that has auto, fire, or casualty insurance. NOTE: If an individual does NOT have auto fire or casualty insurance they WILL NOT be billed for services provided.

a.	Grass fire:	\$	500.00
b.	Rubbish fire:	\$	500.00
C.	Automobile fire:	\$	350.00

These charges are for the first 24 hours for an incident. If an incident lasts more than 24 hours, recipient will be charged actual expenses for incident, including user pay for required subcontractor work or extended on-site requirement.

The BLTFD Chief shall be responsible for determining actual expenses incurred, and length of required response time.

Section 3: Time for Payment Run

All of the foregoing charges shall be due and payable within 30 days from the date the service is rendered. Default of payment shall be collectible through proceedings in District Court or in any court of competent jurisdiction as a matured debt.

Section 4: Exemptions

The following properties and services shall be exempt from the foregoing charges:

- a. False Alarms. However, if BLTFD responds to a false alarm at any location which has had at least four (4) false alarms in the same calendar year, there shall be a charge due and payable pursuant to the terms of Section 3, of \$100.00 for said response and for each subsequent response to a false alarm during the same calendar year.
- b. Fire involving township or county buildings, grounds and/or property.
- Fire service performed outside the jurisdiction of the township under a mutual aid contract.
- d. Medical rescue calls, (chest pain, difficulty breathing etc.)

Section 5: Collection of Charges

BLTFD may proceed in District Court by suit to collect any monies remaining unpaid and shall have any and all other remedies provided by law for the collection of said charges.

Section 6: Non-Exclusive Charges

The foregoing rates and charges shall not be exclusive of the charges that may be made by BLTFD for the costs and expenses of maintaining the department, but shall only be supplemental thereto. Charges may additionally be collected for BLTFD through general taxation after a vote of the electorate approving the same or by a special assessment established under the Michigan statutes pertinent thereto. General fund appropriations may also be made to cover such additional costs and expenses.

Section 7: Multiple Property Protection

When a particular service rendered by BLTFD directly benefits more than one person or

property, the owner of each property so benefited and each person so benefited where property protection is not involved shall be liable for the payment of the full charge for such service hereinbefore outlined. The interpretation and application of the within section is hereby delegated to the BLTFD Fire Chief subject only to appeal, within the time limits for payment and shall be administered so that charges shall only be collected from the recipients of the service.

Section 8: Validity

If any section, provision or clause of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect any remaining portions or application of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid portion or application.

Section 9: Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after being published in a Newspaper of general circulation within the Township.

TOWNSHIP FIRE AND RESCUE REMBURSEMENT ORDINANCE

THE TOWNSHIP OF BEAR LAKE HEREBY

Section 1: Purpose

This ordinance is adopted for the purpose of providing financial relimbursement to the Bear Lake Township Fire Department (hereafter referred to as BLTFD), a service operated by Bear Lake Township, for fire response and/or rescue services performed throughout the BLTFD area of operation.

Section 2: Charges

The following charges shall be billed to any recipient of services provided by BLTFD that has auto, fire, or casualty insurance. NOTE: If an individual does NOT have auto, fire or casualty insurance they WILL NOT be billed for services provided.

Section 3: Time for Payment Run

All of the toregoing charges shall be due and payable within 30 days from the date the service is rendered. Default of payment shall be collectible through pro-ceedings in District Court or in any court of competent jurisdiction as a matured debt,

Section 4: Exemptions

The following properties and services shall be exempt from the foregoing charges:
a. False Alarms, However, if BLTFD responds to a

alse alarm at any location which has had at least four (4) false alarms in the same calendar year, there shall be a charge due and payable pursuant to the terms of Section 3, of \$100.00 for said response and for each subsequent response to a false plant during the
